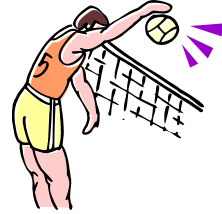

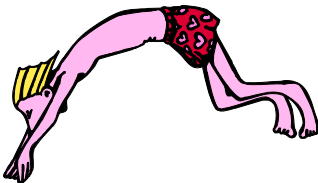

PRESIDENT'S LETTER 2009

Dear Fellow Members:

Our 49th season at Covered Bridge Swim Club begins in less than two short months. Welcome the new summer season by joining your friends and neighbors for opening day at the pool on Saturday, May 23, 2009.

We are expecting another fun and rewarding pool season. From the socials to the organized sports to the swim and dive teams to the everyday lounging by the pool, I hope everyone takes advantage of the many benefits of membership.

We have not increased membership dues for the 2009 season. However, it is now more important than ever that everyone contributes by participating in Proud Owner Days to help offset our expenses. We have scheduled numerous Proud Owner Days this year for everyone's convenience – May 2nd, May 3rd, May 9th, May 16th and May 17th. We need as much help as possible to clean up, spruce up, help with general repairs and generally make the facilities and grounds as nice as possible for the upcoming season. Our club is financially sound, has a strong, committed membership base and a great swim/dive team program. Please come out and join your family, friends and neighbors in all that Covered Bridge has to offer.

Due to its success, we will once again implement the "Lucky Duck" program. All members who submit (postmark) their full dues payment by May 15, 2009 will be eligible for the program. On Memorial Day, Monday May 25th, we will draw six names from the eligible list, and those six members whose names are drawn will receive **\$100.00 each**. The club will issue a \$100 check to each winner or they will be given the option to apply \$100 towards their 2010 membership dues. COVERED BRIDGE SWIM CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT (Athletes)

Purpose

The Code of Conduct outlines the responsibilities and expected behavior of CBSC swimmers and divers (the “Athletes”).

General Conduct Policies

1. Athletes will display proper respect and good sportsmanship by conducting themselves in a manner that earns the respect of coaches, teammates, competitors, parents, officials, and spectators.
2. Athletes will arrive for all practices, meets and team functions on time and ready to participate.
3. Athletes will participate in all team functions to promote an atmosphere of team unity.
4. Athletes will practice with a positive attitude, striving to meet the goals and objectives of each task. Athletes will listen to and respect all coaches.
5. Athletes will refrain from any illegal or inappropriate behavior that could detract from a positive image of CBSC and Tri-County Swimming or be detrimental to these organizations’ objectives. Such behavior includes, but is not limited to, verbal or physical harassment, hazing or bullying.
6. Athletes will refrain from the display of inappropriate, offensive, or otherwise unacceptable behavior.

Violation of Conduct Policies

If an Athlete violates the spirit or letter of one or more of the policies set out above, he/she is subject to one or more of the following consequences, at the sole discretion of his/her Head Coach:

1. Removal from practice or meet.
2. Sent home from practice or meet.
3. Scratched from the upcoming meet.
4. Suspension from the team.

A suspension will remain in effect until the Athlete and one or both parents meet with the Head Coach and the President of CBSC and one other CBSC Board member. Reinstatement to the team, with any or no conditions, will be left to the sole discretion of the CBSC Board.

In addition, if an Athlete, intentionally or through gross negligence, damages any real or personal property, he/she may be subject to pay to repair or replace the property.

I have read and understand this Code of Conduct and agree to abide by it.

Bond and Initiation Fee

Members (except Senior Citizen Associate Members) are required to purchase a \$50 refundable bond and pay a \$350 NON-refundable initiation fee. The \$350 initiation fee is payable as follows:

- a) in full at the start of the season with dues payment;
- b) \$50 up front followed by 3 monthly installments of \$100 each in June, July, and August;
- c) in 3 annual installments of \$100, \$150, and \$150 (includes a \$50 financing fee);
- d) defer initiation payments until the second season with the club when option a, b, or c must be chosen;

Guest Cards: Members are eligible to purchase discounted guest cards when paying their dues. Each guest card entitles the holder to \$15 in guest fees (3 guests). The cost of each card is \$10. Members may also purchase an Out-of-Town Visitor guest pass. See manager for details.

Divers will meet their Head Coach and swimmers will see their Head Coach and Assistant Coaches from last year. Each family is asked to bring a snack or dessert to share.

DIVE PRACTICE SCHEDULE

Dive practice schedules will be posted at the pool when they become available and will be based on the age distribution of the team. Practices will start on May 26th.

LEARN TO SWIM PROGRAM

The Learn To Swim Program will run 2 one-week sessions. The dates and times will be announced in June. All details will be posted at the pool.

ADULT MORNING LAP SWIM

It is our hope to continue to make the pool available to members age 19 & up for lap swimming on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 7-8am. This decision will be based on the availability of lifeguards.

COVERED BRIDGE SWIM CLUB

GENERAL POOL RULES

The pool manager will have complete authority in all matters pertaining to the management and maintenance of the pool as well as the safety and health of its occupants. In his/her absence, a duly appointed staff member shall assume the Pool Manager's responsibilities (Assistant Manager or a Head Lifeguard)

1. No running, pushing, spitting, wrestling, ball playing or disturbance will be tolerated on the deck or in the pool.
2. Goggles and masks may be used in the pool.
3. No rafts or tubes are allowed in the pool except on designated raft nights.
4. No water guns or super soakers are allowed in the pool or pool area except on designated water gun nights.
5. Swimmies may be used only when a child is in the three foot and five foot sections of the pool and accompanied by an adult.
6. No children in diapers are allowed in the adult pool.
7. Chewing gum will not be allowed in the pool area.
8. The lifeguard on duty will decide if the diving boards are open or closed. When the boards are open, one person is allowed on the board at a time. A diver must use the ladder to exit the pool. If the boards are closed, the diving boards may not be used.
9. No diving is allowed in the "shallow" section of the pool. Diving is allowed between the diving blocks in the racing lanes.
10. Children 13 years and under must qualify for the appropriate band to use the lanes and diving area of the pool. See bulletin board for test' information.
11. Cut-off jeans may not be worn in the pool.
12. Children breaking these rules will be benched for a time deemed appropriate by the lifeguard. Multiple infractions of the rules will be dealt with by the Pool Manager.
13. A flagrant violation of any rule makes the violator subject to immediate suspension from the pool premises at the discretion of the Pool Manager.
14. No glass containers of any kind will be permitted at the pool.
15. Food or refreshments may be consumed only in the snack bar area. Sodas may be consumed outside of the snack bar area.
16. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the club property, with the exception of pool-sanctioned adult socials.

All members and guests, including children using the club's facilities, do so at their own risk. The club will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use. The club will not be responsible for any property lost or stolen. A designated lost and found area will hold items for a limited period of time.
